CONDITION OF HIRE: There must be no noxious explosives or dangerous materials placed in the skip. There must be no fires set in or around the skip and the hirer shall be responsible for all expenses to refurbish or replace the skip if any damage is done. The skip must be loaded sensibly with the waste remaining below the rim of the skip; maximum of 7 tonnes for 8-16 yard skips, 8 tonnes max for 6 yard skips, 4 tonnes max for 4 yard skips & 2 tonnes max for 2 yard skips. If the hirer fails to load the skip correctly the company/driver withholds the right not to collect the waste. The company/driver shall not be held responsible for damage done to the hirer's property; it is the hirer's responsibility. If the skip requires traffic cones the hirer must ensure that they are positioned correctly in order to guide traffic safely past them. The hirer must also ensure that the lamps are illuminated and positioned correctly at night or in bad weather conditions. If the hirer wishes to keep the skip longer than the agreed period they must ring up and arrange extra payment in order to do so. You must have a permit from your local council if the skip is being placed on a public highway. If the hirer fails to declare that the skip is being placed on a public highway when asked prior to the delivery, then the company/driver withholds the right to not deliver the skip and a charge will be made to the hirer from Wastesure for the transport of the skip.
